 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. EXCEPTION TO CERTAIN REPORTING REQUIRE-
2	MENTS APPLICABLE TO FOREIGN FINANCIAL
3	INSTITUTIONS WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN
4	INDIVIDUALS WHO LIVE ABROAD.
5	(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1471(d)(1) of the Inter-
6	nal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by redesignating
7	subparagraph (C) as subparagraph (D) and by inserting
8	after subparagraph (B) the following new subparagraph:
9	"(C) EXCEPTION FOR CERTAIN INDIVID-
10	UALS WHO LIVE IN THE SAME FOREIGN COUN-
11	TRY AS THE FOREIGN FINANCIAL INSTITUTION
12	IS ORGANIZED.—
13	"(i) IN GENERAL.—Unless the foreign
14	financial institution elects to not have this
15	subparagraph apply, such term shall not
16	include any depository account maintained
17	by such financial institution if each holder
18	of such account is—
19	"(I) a natural person, and
20	"(II) a qualified individual with
21	respect to the foreign country under
22	the laws of which such foreign finan-
23	cial institution is organized.
24	"(ii) Qualified individual.—For
25	purposes of this subparagraph, an indi-
26	vidual is a qualified individual with respect

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1	to any foreign country if such individual
2	would be a qualified individual under sec-
3	tion 911(d) if the only foreign country
4	taken into account under such section were
5	such foreign country.".
6	(b) Effective Date.—
7	(1) IN GENERAL.—The amendments made by
8	this section shall take effect on the date of the en-
9	actment of this Act.
10	(2) Modification of agreements.—At the
11	request of any foreign financial institution, the Sec-
12	retary of the Treasury (or the Secretary's delegate)
13	shall, as promptly as is practicable, modify any
14	agreement which is in effect between the Secretary
15	and such foreign financial institution under section
16	1471 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to take
17	into account the amendments made by this section.
18	SEC. 2. EXCEPTION FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS WHO LIVE
19	ABROAD TO CERTAIN REPORTING REQUIRE-
20	MENTS APPLICABLE TO INDIVIDUALS WITH
21	FOREIGN FINANCIAL ASSETS.
22	(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6038D of the Internal
23	Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by redesignating sub-
24	section (h) as subsection (i) and by inserting after sub-
25	section (g) the following new subsection:

"(h) EXCEPTION FOR CERTAIN FINANCIAL AC 2 COUNTS OF INDIVIDUALS LIVING ABROAD.—

3 "(1) IN GENERAL.—In the case of a qualified 4 individual with respect to any foreign country, sub-5 section (a) shall not apply to such individual for any 6 taxable year if such individual would not be required 7 to provide any information under such subsection for 8 such taxable year if the qualified foreign accounts in 9 which such individual holds an interest were not 10 taken into account as specified foreign financial as-11 sets for purposes of this section.

12 "(2) QUALIFIED FOREIGN ACCOUNT.—For pur-13 poses of this subsection, the term 'qualified foreign 14 account' means, with respect to any gualified indi-15 vidual, any account described in subsection (b)(1)16 which is maintained by a financial institution orga-17 nized under the laws of the same foreign country 18 with respect to which such individual is a qualified 19 individual.

20 "(3) QUALIFIED INDIVIDUAL.—For purposes of
21 this subsection, an individual is a qualified indi22 vidual with respect to any foreign country if such in23 dividual would be a qualified individual under sec24 tion 911(d) if the only foreign country taken into ac-

count under such section were such foreign coun try.".

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
4 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
5 the date of the enactment of this Act.
