- Update from the Chair (30 minutes)
  - ⇒ Now is the time to evaluate our structures and processes (think 2024)
  - **⇒** Question for all present:

As Caucus Chair - what do you want start/stop/continue?

- o Angela- Would like an easier way to connect with Dem politicians. / Continue FB Live, weekly reports, All Caucus Newsletter
- Ann Start establishing a better system for global webinar scheduling /Stop more single issue caucuses /Continue defining relationships between local and global caucuses
- o Brooke start doing events with a strong and intentional bilingual component, whether they are in Spanish with English translations/discussion options, or English with Spanish translations/discussion options. This would mean publishing our materials and information in Spanish, possibly with a Spanish language translation component using Zoom. We've started doing this with our event updates but we're looking to do this more systematically and meaningfully.
  - Start serious outreach to bilingual or Spanish-speaking dual residents around the world but most notably in the Americas. This follows with a "stop" in that we want to stop perpetuating the idea that there are no Americans in certain countries or communities, especially count
  - Database of leadership with Hispanic heritage
  - Interregional Cohesion Planning between regions and informational exchange
- Cory Starts Language Chinese/Korean/Tagalog need this in Spanish in order to have this in other languages. AP Leaders should be reaching out to AAPI DA members/communities overseas. Stops - only certain ethnicities can deal with specific issues - think more holistically.
- Courtney Start working more intentionally with Excom&Caucus Leaders. Start working on different events and issues across the board. Defining structures between global and local caucuses.
- Candice all Caucus leaders are invited to Excom meetings and are invited to speak
- o Emily START establishing clear relationships between global and local caucuses needs clear communication to all parties. CONTINUE monthly meetings, discussion opportunities. Important to have identity discussions but they should be pushed at a higher level than only the individual caucuses
- o Erin Start google calendar to track what everyone is doing, country and global levels need clear definitions bad representation crosses borders. Who can do

- what where and who they are representing would be helpful. STOP decisions about the caucus without consulting the caucus. No Ghosting please.
- o Martha Global vs local caucuses this tension needs to be recognized and we need to recognize the independence of local Excoms. Resources that we currently have are so good, start making use of data and be more result driven. Will take Start/Stop/continue to the LGBTQ+ team. Due to innovation over last 4 years, we have a new ability to scale our work. Continue doing Legislative work, and cross-caucus work / intersectionality. Uniqueness of caucuses is our strength, but we can also funnel this strength. Have more generative discussions.
- o Nicholas How do we manage autonomy of caucuses within DA without creating redundancy and conflict. Need to think about planning management.
- Bob We need more guidelines with country caucuses. Would like more demographic info. Branding and logo guidelines are still unclear. Continuing advocacy for vets and onbase. Bases are controlled by local commanders, so VFA can be disallowed.

#### ⇒ Candice

- o One priority is defining the relationships between global and local caucuses
- o 100 days is the goal for changes and evaluation where we are and what we want to do.
  - What can we do to make this happen in the 100 days
  - No more unilateral appts
  - This will be an open transparent process
  - Descriptions and notification will go out to everyone by the 2nd week of June (Job descriptions and time commitments will be listed)
    - Everyone should re-apply for the role that you wish to have for global leads
    - Hope to have this all up and running by end of August
    - Email Candice at chair@democratsabroad.org with any questions
  - These appointments will be Excom votes, and anyone can be appointed.
  - Chairs will be consulted about appointments and structure as the job descriptions are developed
