For fax or postal mail only states (no emailing allowed): AK, CA, FL, LA*

So, if you don't have access to a fax machine, here are some tips on ways to turn an email attachment (pdf file) into a fax:

- 1. There are various smartphone applications that will convert an email attachment to a fax. Print, fill in and scan in your ballot and any required materials as an email attachment, then search for "fax app for Android/iPhone" on application platforms like Apple's App Store, Google Play Store, Galaxie Store, etc. Follow the instructions to convert your email attachment into a fax transmission.
- 2. Or, you can use the Fax service through the Federal Voting Assistance Program (<u>FVAP.gov</u>). You will need to email your ballot and any required supporting materials to this address: <u>fax@fvap.gov</u>

You must use FVAP's fax coversheet: www.fvap.gov/uploads/FVAP/Forms/coversheet.pdf.

FVAP will then fax your election materials to your Local Election Official.

But *don't wait until the last minute when using the FVAP fax service!* The service can get overloaded and FVAP does not guarantee that your voted ballot will be faxed to your Local Election Official by the deadline.

*For Louisiana: note that there's an extra requirement that the voter must make prior arrangement with their Local Election Office
