PROPOSITION #3:

Establishment of Standing Committees

WHEREAS, there are certain areas of activities that require contral at entior by the DPCA leadership;

WHEREAS, the Officers of the International Executive Commune have tasks relating to their individual officer positions that preclude them from ontinual, seending to these areas of activities;

WHEREAS, these areas of activities include aron ation Technology ("IT"), Membership/Voter Registration, Issues, Erants, Fundraishin, Affirmative Action, and Newsletter/Communications ("Communications")

WHEREAS, the IT Standing Commutee in a final de tasks relating to the technical, legal, and content aspects of information technology, and other relevant tasks and activities, covering areas that the pertinent to among others the International Secretary, International Counsel, and International Treasuler;

WHEREAS, the Membership/Voto An gistration Standing Committee may include tasks such as growing membership database in cooperation with the International Secretary, voter registration, getting out the vote, and other relevant tasks and activities;

WHEREAS, the visues Standing Committee may include tasks relating to issues such taxation of American citizens abroad, gun safety, healthcare, etc., and other relevant tasks a coactivities; and liaise with caucuses such as the Progressive Caucus and the Women's Caucus

WHEN TAS, the Events Standing Committee may include tasks relating to rallies, fundraising events, commemorations, election night celebrations, voter registration, getting out the pote events, and other relevant tasks and activities;

WHEREAS, the Fundraising Standing Committee may include tasks relating to raising funds for Democrats Abroad, including through on-site fundraising and auctions, and other relevant tasks and activities;

WHEREAS, the Affirmative Action Standing Committee may include tasks relating to affirmative action issues within Democrats Abroad as well as the broader American

society, and other relevant tasks and activities; and liaise with caucuses such as the LGBT Caucus, the Black Caucus, the Hispanic Caucus, the Youth Caucus, etc.;

WHEREAS, the Communications Standing Committee may include tasks relating to framing messages, information to the membership, social media, media appearances, and other relevant tasks and activities;

WHEREAS, Standing Committees relating to these areas of activities should be created by the International Chair and approved by the elected members of the International Executive Committee;

WHEREAS, the chairs of these Standing Committees should be appointed in the International Chair with approval by a majority of the elected members of the International Executive Committee;

WHEREAS, the chairs of these Standing Committees should exuffice be non-voting members of the Executive Committee;

WHEREAS, similar standing committees should be enclosed at the regional level;

WHEREAS, with the exception of the IT Standing Committee Country Committees should be encouraged to establish similar standing committees;

WHEREAS, by doing so, Democrats Abro. L will b come a nore effective organization with improved internal communications through zation. allowing to extend from the international level communication regarding these are iviti 500 to the regional and Country Computee level e versa, as well as lateral ١d communication between Courty C nmittees:

WHEREAS, Sections 3.4 (Quorun, 4.6 Responsibilities of the International Chair), and 6.3 (Duties of Regional Vice Chairs) if the Tomocrats Abroad Charter should be amended to include randing normittees in the Charter;

THEREFORE, BUIT ESOLVE, that Section 3.4 of the Democrats Abroad Charter be modified as follows:

"Section 31 (Quorum)

the reaction of a meeting shall require the presence in person or -line of

e International Chair or Vice Chair of the DPCA; and

(b) 40% of DPCA members; and

(c) for meetings of Standing Committees, including Regional Standing Committees, or ad hoc committees, the Chair and/or the Vice Chair of that committee and one other committee member.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the case of annual meetings under Section 3.1, a quorum shall require the physical presence or presence by proxy to a member physically present of at least 20% of DPCA members as well as the physical presence of either the International Chair or Vice Chair. In addition, for quorum purposes, the individuals referred to in paragraph (b) must include members resident in at least four (4) different countries and two (2) Regions."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Section 4.6 of the Democrats Abroad Chan r shall be amended as follows:

"Section 4.6 (Responsibilities of the International

(a) The International Chair shall be responsible the of the programs and policies of the Demo ntic Partv Democrats Abroad. The International Chall preside She meetings of the DPCA, establishing its agen agendas. and implementing its decisions t ing D A meetings. en a Following consultation with the Com ttee. the xecutiv International Chair may appoint of ant officers (such appointments shall be p potined to the DPCA) and conduct the day-to-day busines of Demo broad. The International ats Chair shall be the chief s akespers for the organization. The International Chair ma afts consu ation with the Executive Committee, c mittees and determine their ate or t nate compositi e International Chair shall ex officio bse. oting met ber of all committees. be a ng

(b) The International Chair shall appoint the following Standing Committees: Internation Technology ("IT"), Membership/Voter Registration, Issue, Events, Fundraising, Affirmative Action, and New letters communications ("Communications").

(c) <u>A staternational Chair shall appoint or remove the chairs of</u> <u>the Standing Committees subject to ratification by the elected</u> <u>is the standing Committee states next meeting following</u> <u>such appointments or revocation. Standing Committee chairs shall</u> <u>ex officio be non-voting members of the Executive Committee. The</u> <u>membership of each Standing Committee shall be selected by the</u> <u>respective committee chair after consultation with the International</u> <u>Chair.</u>" BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Section 6.3 of the Democrats Abroad Charter shall be amended as follows:

"Section 6.3 (Duties of Regional Vice Chairs)

(a) The Regional Vice Chairs shall, under the direction of the International Chair, promote cooperation among the Country Committees in the respective Regions and implement any

Regional programs or plans adopted by the Regional Committees, provided such programs or plans have been approved by the International Chair in consultation with Executive Committee.

(b) The Regional Vice Chairs shall appoint the follow to Sequenal Standing Committees: Information Technology (TT"). Membership/Voter Registration, Issues, Events, Fundrating, Affirmative Action, and Newsletter/Communications ("Communications").

(c) The Regional Vice Chairs sh nove the chairs of appl nt or T the Regional Standing Commit sultation with the es in c International Chair. Regional Stan chairs shall be COL appointed from among respective region who in t -mbe. have the required know edge and required to chair the sk respective Regional Standing Comm ttee. The membership of each Standing Commune st l be a lected by the respective Regional Starking Co after consultation with the tee Region I Vice Chairs shall ex officio be non-Regional ce Cr e respective Regional Standing Committees. votina bers of l

(d) the Regional Vice Quairs shall consult with the the individual <u>Grunt Committie Chairs in their respective regions to</u> <u>enclurate the respective Country Committees, in accordance</u> with the respective Country Committee bylaws, to establish <u>separate standing committees corresponding to the following</u> region. Standing Committees: Membership/Voter Registration, <u>spices, Events, Fundraising, Affirmative Action, and</u>

sletter/Communications ("Communications").
