WHEREAS the evictoric for its above point can be readily had by tossing a coin ten times. The odds of getting five hands and five tails are low. Thus only when gender imbalance is statistically anificance greater should gender/sex equity be considered;

WHEREAS DIC ros do not equire 50 - 50 equity in all matters of voting;

BE IT FOSOLVI. O that is a Country Committee has more than two Voting Represelvances (Chair and Vice-Chair), gender balance shall not apply unless sexuandel unback to exceeds statistical significance. Then gender will be taken into account

BE IT FURTA RESOLVED that Section 3.6 (f) of the Democrats Abroad Charter shall be amended by striking the phrase "If a Country Committee has more than one (1) Voting Representative, gender balance shall apply."

"Section 3.6 (Voting)

(f) Each Country Committee shall have the option to elect non-voting Representatives, and shall be required to elect at least

the minimum number of Voting Representatives necessary to enable it to cast all its votes. Such election(s) shall be held at the same time as the election of a Country Committee's Chair and Vice Chair. If a Country Committee has more than one (1) Voting Representative, gender balance shall apply. The term of a Voting Representative shall be the same as for Officers of the Country Committee. All Voting Representatives shall be entitled to attend all Democrats Abroad meetings during the same two (2)-year term as for the Country Committee Chair and Vice Chair offices. If a Committee is entitled to less than five (5) votes, the Voting Representative, if any, shall have the ri DPCA meetings but not to vote, except under \$ below. If a Country Committee is entitled votes, the distribution of votes among the Cha and Voting Representative(s) (if any all be det the Country Committee at the time of failing which by the Country Committee Ch er, that a Voting Representative sha an one (1) vote o less nor more votes than the Cou Chair or Vice mmitte Chair.
