Member Verification

Progress and Deadlines

Each year on January 31st, DA takes a snapshot of our database in order to determine the official number of each country's valid members, who must meet the following conditions:

- Be already approved as a member
- Have a full local street address and/or phone number
- Be verified as a valid member within the past 4 years.

More importantly, the annual membership cleanup serves to make sure we have valid information about our members. The secondary purpose is that the membership count numbers are used to determine DPCA votes per Country Committee.

Through the data clean-up efforts of the Global IT Team, DA Global has already resolved the following:

- Phone numbers: Fixed over 9,000 phone numbers and deleted about 1,000 inactive numbers.
- Emails: Removed about 6,000 invalid emails and verified 2,500.
- Duplicates: Merged approximately 900 duplicate member records.

DA China needs to do the same! Leadership Board members have been working on member verification. Since August, our Secretary and Vice Chair have begun the process of verification at the local level. We have a long way to go, however. November will be our largest push to verify current member info, we have over 1,000 accounts to update. While our host country has some of the strictest relocation policies, DA Global Chair Candice Kerestan has asserted members stuck outside of their host countries are still able to be counted and included.

Ensure your personal member data is accurate on our website today by logging in and adjusting settings as needed.
















DISABILITY CAUCUS



The pandemic has given new life to the term snail mail, courier services are recommended for submitting paper ballots. Request and submit your ballot ASAP!!!

Florida - Special Primary in Congressional District 20: U.S. House of Representatives.

- Ballot Requests due October 23 via email, fax, or postal mail.
- Ballots must be Returned via Fax or Postal Mail are due by November 2.
- Ballots must be Received by November 12.

Ohio - Special General Election in Congressional Districts 11 & 15.

Deadline to Request a Ballot by Email, Fax, or Mail is October 30.

- Returned Ballots via Regular Mail must be Postmarked by November 1, and Received by November 12.
- Returned Ballots via Courier Services must be Received by November 2. (DHL, FedEx...)
- Ohio voters should verify their voting district.
- Information in English and Spanish is now available on the DA website.

New Jersey - General: Governor and other state offices.

- Request ballots by October 29.
- Return Ballots by Email, Fax, or Mail. If returned by Email or Fax, voters must also put original ballot in the mail.
- Ballots are due November 2.
- Note policies regarding "intending to return" affect your ability to vote. Visit the DA page for NJ state for FAQs and to learn how to ensure A5306/S3761 passes the NJ Senate.

Virginia - General: Governor and other state offices.

- Return ballots by November 2 (by 7PM Eastern).
- Ballots must be received by November 5 (by 12PM Eastern).
- All About VA
- Keep Virginia BLUE! All ballots must be mailed, RETURN YOUR BALLOTS TODAY!

ALL VOTERS - If you have not received a ballot yet, we recommend you mail in a Backup Ballot (the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot, or FWAB).

FWAB is only for overseas voters and protects your right to vote in case your official ballot doesn't arrive in time.

HOW TO MAIL BACK YOUR BALLOT

All States have a deadline for when they will accept arrived ballots, even if the ballot was postmarked before November 3rd! SO SEND IT ASAP!

Download and print your envelope!

Either print directly onto an existing envelope or print on paper and paste to an envelope.

Check Courier Services!

7-14 days est ~387rmb 7-14 days est ~372rmb SF Express 3-5 days est ~222rmb

Make sure you:

- have a non-P0 box address
- keep envelopes unsealed until the courier shows up
- categorize the envelope as "Completed Document"


BYLAWS

SHUFFLE

The Executive Committee will henceforth consist of a Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, Communications Director, and IT Director.

Members-At-Large position changes are coming! Prior to 2023's AGM, the current group of five Members-At-Large will be split. Two Members-At-Large will be elected with pre-designated duties (e.g. Volunteer Coordinator, or Caucus Liaison). Two Members-At-Large will be elected without pre-designated assignments, will be termed "General Members-At-Large." Each will assist the Board with DA China missions and have responsibilities designated throughout the term. Additionally, a GOTV Coordinator will serve as a voting member of the Board and be tasked with leading voter registration for DACN.

The non-voting members assisting and advising the Leadership Board shall consist of up to three appointed Deputy Communications Officers, as well as an appointed General Counsel.

FALL MEETING 2021

During the Fall Meeting of the DNC, which was held from October 7-9, Adrianne George, who resides in Sweden and is one of eight members who represents Democrats Abroad on the DNC, was elected to the Credentials Committee along with the full slate of Chair Harrison's nominees.

DA China's former Chair, Aaron Kruse, also attended the Fall Meetings. Aaron serves as DA's APAC elected DNC member. We would like to recognize and thank him for his dedication to the Democratic cause!

The most prominent agenda item on the otherwise predominately procedural meeting was the status of the upcoming 2021 gubernatorial races - in Virginia and New Jersey - now just a week away. Saying we are "laser-focused on the elections underway in Virginia," DNC Chair Jaime Harrison said the national Party had made an unprecedented \$5 million investment in the battleground race where Democratic nominee and former Governor Terry McAuliffe and Republican Glenn Youngkin are in a dead heat.

The DNC followed in DA's footsteps and created an official Disability Caucus. This could not have been done without DNC member and DA Global Disability Caucus Steering Committee Member Ken Sherman.

In his remarks, President Biden was forthright in his assessment of the challenges before us as a party, and as a people, on the pandemic, voting rights, immigration, the courts, gun safety, healthcare and a woman's right to choose. His central message was a call for unity, saying:

> "We need to stay together, bound by the values we hold as a party. Here's the deal. We won 2020 as a unified party, and as we look to 2022, we need to stay unified... Let's get it done."

ARTICLE XVI

PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENTS

PROPOSED AMENDMENT 16.8

16.8 Finance. The NEC has no direct spending authority. Any election expenditures deemed necessary by the NEC must firstly be submitted in written form to the Chair or Treasurer at least 30 days prior to any election or AGM. Expenses must be approved by a majority ExCom vote in a special meeting held within 5 days of formal request.
