Hi Mr. Hernandez,

It was great to talk with you this afternoon (Thursday)--and thanks so much for for all your help with my questions about overseas voting. I volunteer with Vote From Abroad, so I'll be happy to get this information out to overseas RI voters! I wanted to confirm that:

- 1. If an overseas voter is not yet registered to vote, they must send in their FPCA form by Sunday, Oct 7th.
 - If sent by Mail, the form must be Postmarked by Oct 7th.
 - If sent by Email or Fax, the form must be Received by Oct 7th And the voter should also send in the original FPCA by Mail
- 2. There is no deadline to request a ballot if an overseas voter is already registered to vote in RI
 - The FPCA to request a ballot may be sent in by Email, Fax or Mail up until 8pm on Election Day
 - Voted Ballots may be sent in by Email, Fax or Mail and must be Received by 8pm on Election Day
 - If a voter doesn't received their official ballot in time, they may submit a FWAB by 8pm on Election Day and that would also count as their Ballot Request
