Hi Crystal,

Nice talking to you and thanks so much for clearing up the confusion on the dates for Idaho voters who vote from overseas.

To confirm our conversation:

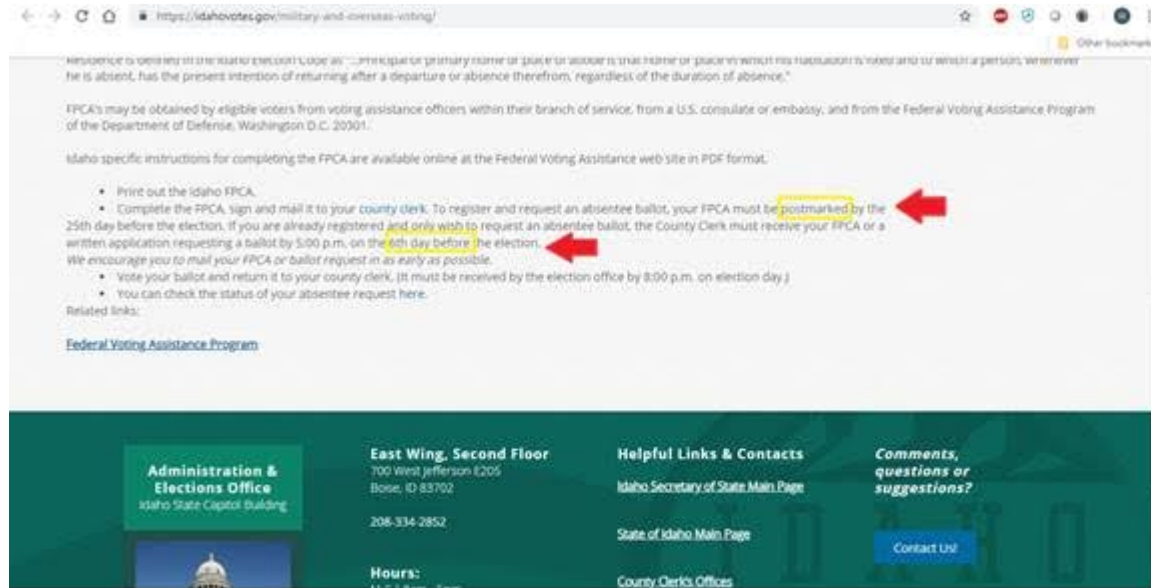
1. To **register to vote** using the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA), the form must be **Received** in Idaho by Friday, Oct 12th (25 days before the election).

It is not a "postmarked" deadline as indicated on the Idaho webpage for military and overseas voters.

2. To **request a ballot**, the FPCA must be received in Idaho by **Friday, Oct 26th at 5pm** (11 days before the election). It is not the 6th day before the election as indicated on the Idaho webpage for military and overseas voters
