Hello,

I'm a volunteer helping US citizens, living overseas, vote in US elections. We want to make sure that votefromabroad.org provides accurate and up-to-date voting information. Would you please answer the following questions.

- 1. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and they <u>intend to return</u>, are they allowed to vote in <u>state</u> elections? Yes If lowa was the last place of residence for an overseas civilian before they left the United States they are an eligible lowa voter and can vote in any election.
- 2. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and their return is <u>uncertain</u>, are they allowed to vote in <u>state</u> elections? Yes If Iowa was the last place of residence for an overseas civilian before they left the United States they are an eligible Iowa voter and can vote in any election.
- 3. If a U.S. citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in <u>state</u> elections? Yes, but only if their parent was an lowa resident immediately before leaving the US.
- 4. If a US citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in <u>federal</u> elections? Yes, but only if their parent was an lowa resident immediately before leaving the US.
