Dear Minnesota State Election Administartor,

I'm a volunteer helping US citizens living overseas vote in US elections. We want to make sure that votefromabroad.org provides accurate and up-to-date voting information. Would you please answer the following questions

1. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and their return is certain, are they allowed to vote in state elections? **Yes**
2. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and their return is uncertain, are they allowed to vote in state elections? **No, only federal elections**
3. If a U.S. citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in state elections? **No**
4. If a US citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in federal elections? **Yes, if a parent maintained residence in Minnesota for at least 20 days prior to their departure from the U.S.**

Thank you for taking the time to answer our questions. We appreciate you helping Americans execute one of their most important rights!
