- 1. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and their return is certain, are they allowed to vote in state elections? Yes
- 2. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and their return is uncertain, are they allowed to vote in state elections? No, only federal elections
- 3. If a U.S. citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in state elections? No
- 4. If a US citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in federal elections? Yes, if a parent maintained residence in Minnesota for at least 20 days prior to their departure from the U.S.
