I'm a volunteer helping US citizens, living overseas, vote in US elections. We want to make sure that votefromabroad.org provides accurate and up-to-date voting information. Would you please answer the following questions.

1. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and they intend to return, are they allowed to vote in state elections? **Yes.**

2. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and their return is uncertain, are they allowed to vote in state elections? **Yes.**

3. If a U.S. citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in state elections? **Yes.**

4. If a US citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in federal elections? **Yes.**
