Good Afternoon,

If a U.S. citizen (formerly a Pennsylvania resident) residing abroad and intends to return, **they are** eligible to vote in state elections, which would include ballot questions.

If a U.S. citizen (formerly a Pennsylvania resident) residing abroad and return is not certain, **they are** only eligible to vote for federal offices, i.e., President, U.S. Senate and Representative in Congress.

If a U.S. citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in state elections-No

If a US citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in federal elections-No
