Thank you for contacting our office.

A voter may request a UOCAVA ballot up until the Thursday before the election (November 1).

Regarding the return of the ballot, a UOCAVA ballot must be received by the appropriate election officer "not later than the close of the polls" (e.g., 8PM MST on November 6) or "submitted for mailing, electronic transmission, or other authorized means of delivery not later than 12:01 a.m., at the place where the voter completes the ballot, on the date of the election."

Comment / Suggestion - Hi, I'm a volunteer with VoteFromAbroad--we help US citizens and military personnel living overseas when they have questions about voting when they live outside the US or US territories. We are preparing emails to provide voting information for Utah voters and we found some conflicting information that we'd like to confirm with your office: If a voter is already registered and uses the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) to request their overseas ballot, what is the deadline for the FPCA to be Received in Utah? According to FVAP.gov, the deadline for receipt is Oct 30th (<https://www.fvap.gov/guide/chapter2/utah>); however, the Overseas Vote Foundation lists the deadline as Nov 1st (<https://www.overseasvotefoundation.org/vote/state-elections/state-election-dates-deadlines.htm?uocava=true&stateName=UT>) Thank you--we appreciate your help in getting accurate information out to overseas voters!
