Hi,

I wanted to check on the deadline for overseas (civilian) voters to register to vote for the June 12 Virginia Primary.

When I went to FVAP.gov, it says the deadline to register to vote is June 5 (www.fvap.gov/virginia)

But on the Virginia website for overseas voters, it says that FPCAs must be received on the final day of registration, which is generally 22 days before the election--that would be **May 21** (www.elections.virginia.gov/registration/military-overseas)

And May 21 is listed on the 2018 Election Calendar as the last day of voter registration (www.elections.virginia.gov/me dia/calendars-schedules/election-deadlines.html)

Can you tell me which is the correct date?
