Please see the following answers to your enquiry;

1. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and they intend to return, are they allowed to vote in state elections?

Yes, the voter can apply for an Absentee Application beginning January 1 each calendar year or 84 days before the election, whichever is sooner.

- **2.** If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and their return is uncertain, are they allowed to vote in state elections? Yes, the voter can apply for an Absentee Application beginning January 1 each calendar year or 84 days before the election, whichever is sooner.
- 3. If a U.S. citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in state elections?

If their parent's last residence was in WV, then the voter can vote in state elections.

4. If a US citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in federal elections?

If their parent's last residence was in WV, then the voter can vote in federal elections.
