**Hello Ms. Parry:**

**Please see the following answers to your enquiry;**

**1. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and they intend to return, are they allowed to vote in state elections?**

Yes, the voter can apply for an Absentee Application beginning January 1 each calendar year or 84 days before the election, whichever is sooner.

**2. If a U.S. citizen is residing abroad and their return is uncertain, are they allowed to vote in state elections?**

Yes, the voter can apply for an Absentee Application beginning January 1 each calendar year or 84 days before the election, whichever is sooner.

**3. If a U.S. citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in state elections?**

If their parent's last residence was in WV, then the voter can vote in state elections.

**4. If a US citizen has never resided in the United States, are they eligible to vote in federal elections?**

If their parent's last residence was in WV, then the voter can vote in federal elections.
