Hi,

I'm a volunteer with VoteFromAbroad--we help US citizens and military personnel living overseas when they have questions about voting when they live outside the US.

We are preparing emails to provide voting information for overseas AS voters and we found some conflicting information that we'd like to confirm:

1. If a voter uses the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) to register to vote and they send in their FPCA by Email or Fax, do they also need to Mail it in?

Answer: They don't have to. They can keep it as their voting record. We can move forward with a copy of the FPCA.

2. If a voter is already registered and uses the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) to request their overseas ballot and they send in their FPCA by Email or Fax, do they also need to Mail it in?

Answer: Same as answer for question# 1

3. Will you provide blank overseas ballot by Email/Online or Fax as requested in an FPCA--or will blank ballots

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only be provided by Mail to overseas voters?

No, we will not provide a BLANK Ballot through mail or electronic.
