We value our U.S. citizenship and retain a strong, personal connection to the nation.

We also face some unique tax challenges, with personal and financial consequences that Congress can help address. We look forward to discussing how.

2019 Research developed for Congress indicates -

- 32% moved abroad for marriage, a relationship or family reasons;
- 25% had left the U.S. for work or employment;
- 61% have household income of less than \$100,000;
- 72% are married, 71% to a non-U.S. spouse;
- 97% have serious problems filing taxes;
- 1 in 3 are hurt by discriminatory tax rules;
- 31% have been denied essential financial products by foreign banks;
- 28% have been denied U.S. investments.
