




FOR THE PEOPLE ACT

- Makes Election Day a Public Holiday
- Mandates 2 weeks of early federal voting
- Bans gerrymandering (usescomputer models instead)
- Allows alternatives to a Voter ID (utility bill etc.)
- Automatic DMV Voter registration
- Mandatory Absentee ballot sent if not present





- Notifies individuals if polling place has changed
- Disclose Act, Honest Ads Act
- No lobbyist for foreign entity allowed
- Mandatory tax returns for President and VP
- Presidential Cabinet appointees must recuse themselves
- Reigns in Super Pacs with a coordinated spender category





- Response to gutting of the Voting Rights Act of 1965 in 2006
- Creates a formula to catch Voting laws that racially discriminate
- Rolls Back Discriminatory voter laws from last 25 years
- Continues to track states with history of racial discrimination (free after 10 years)
- Increases protections for Native American and Alaskan voters
- Attorney General can deploy federal observers in areas with serious threat of racial discrimination
- Requires Public notices for voting changes
- Allows a Federal Court to order states or jurisdictions to be covered for results-based violations



Suggested Action by Adam Bucky

"A country that cannot protect voting rights for all its citizens is no longer a democracy. Whether through the For the People Act or the John Lewis Voting Rights Act, Congress must take action to prevent antidemocratic voter suppression. Democracy is an end for which legislative procedure is merely a means, yet the Senate seems set to abandon democracy in order to protect its procedures. It therefore remains urgent that the House continue to put pressure on the Senate, and the Senate on its recalcitrant members who would rather defend their filibuster than our democracy."
